June 3, 2020

A special meeting of the Town of Grand Lake Board of Supervisors was called to order at 12:30 PM via teleconference on GoToMeeting. All Board members present. The meeting was called for the purposes of discussion planning for Grand Lake Township regarding COVID-19 and Grand Lake Township Facilities reopening. Also present via phone Andy Donahue from Proctor Baseball.

Grand Lake Township Facilities – Re-Open plan:

D. Anderson presented Resolution 2020-06-01 COVID-19 Guidelines for Grand Lake Township Facilities. Board reviewed the proposed resolution. D. Anderson made a motion to accept Resolution 2020-06-01 COVID-19 Guidelines for Grand Lake Township Facilities. Discussion, board indicated that they will rely heavily on the CDC guidelines and MN Governor directives. Our intent of item 1 is adopting governor's orders as revised or supplemented and those of the CDC as they pertain to the facilities, this will preclude the board from having to meet every time the MN Governor issues a new order or a revision to an existing order. Continued discussion regarding having renters sign a form that will be attached to their rental application that they will abide by the MN Governor's guidelines and recommendations of the CDC. Also note that organized groups such as sports, etc. will have to submit a written plan for additional guidance they are following. Motion 2nd by D. Johnson. All in favor, motion carried.

Additional item for discussion in relation to biffies at the Grand Lake facilities. Clerk to check with Brent's Septic on how they are keeping up with the demand of cleaning and how are they handling it? D. Johnson will also look into this issue; we will continue this item for discussion at our June 9th meeting.

Discussion that one of our AIS inspectors was in close contact with COVID-19 patients. They were tested on May 25th, following the test the inspector may return to work as long as there have been no symptoms as soon as June 8th or sooner if a negative test result is received. Will be further discussed at our June 9th meeting.

Surveys were received by Alta for Triple Lakes Road and Birch Point Road. Will continue to discuss at the June 9th meeting.

On a motion made by D. Anderson and 2nd by D. Johnson the special meeting was adjourned at 1PM.
