ORDINANCE 1979-1

Any dog that habitually chases, molests or worries persons travelling peaceably on a public road or causes repeated problems upon the private property of others, shall be declared a nuisance, (State of Minnesota Statute 110.20), and upon a written complaint of a citizen to the Town Board of Supervisors, the owner shall be ordered by the Board to cause the nuisance dog to be leashed and under control at all times. Failure to do so shall be a misdemeanor and penalties provided by law shall be imposed.

In cases where the ownership of the dog is not determined, the dog shall be boarded for a period of five days, whereupon, if not claimed, shall be properly disposed of.

Where the ownership is determined, all costs of enforcement, boarding or claiming of the dog shall be imposed upon the owner. Upon recovery of the dog, the owner shall be responsible for the restraint requirements of the ordinance as written. Failure to do so shall be declared a misdemeanor.
