

Amendment to PLAWCS Ordinance No. 1999-1

AN ORDINANCE CREATING A SEWER UTILITY; REGULATING THE USE OF PUBLIC AND PRIVATE SEWERS; ESTABLISHING METHODS FOR A SEWER SERVICE CHARGE SYSTEM; AND PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATIONS OF THE REGULATIONS HEREIN DEFINED.

The Town Board of Canosia and the Town Board of Grand Lake, both in St. Louis County, Minnesota (the "Towns") ordain the following Amendment to Section 12.4 of PLAWCS Ordinance No. 1999-1 regarding collection:

ARTICLE XII PENALTIES FOR ORDINANCE VIOLATION


Section 12.4 Collection

- a) To collect delinquent sewer service charges, and related expenses, including attorney's fees and penalties:
 - i) PLAWCS may file a civil action suit; or
 - ii) The Town in which the property is located may levy a lien against the violator's property; or
 - iii) The Town in which the property is located may certify unpaid charges, penalties and related expenses, including attorneys' fees, to the County Auditor with taxes against the property served, for collection as other taxes are collected.


